

# Clinical Oversight Review Board (CORB) Criteria for Prescribing Cantharidin 0.7% Topical Solution (YCANTH)

## Notes:

- \* Intolerance excludes adverse drug reactions that are expected, mild in nature, resolve with continued treatment, and do not require medication discontinuation
- \*\* Tretinoin 0.05% cream only required if molluscum contagiosum is located on the face

Non-Formulary **cantharidin 0.7% topical solution (YCANTH)** requires a clinical review. Appropriateness of therapy will be based on the following criteria:

**Initiation (new start) criteria:** Non-Formulary **cantharidin 0.7% solution (YCANTH)** will be covered for up to 4 treatments when the following criteria are met:

- Prescriber is a dermatologist
- Patient has a diagnosis of molluscum contagiosum
- Patient has failed an adequate trial of, or patient has an allergy or intolerance\* to, the following treatments:
  - Salicylic acid 17%
  - Liquid nitrogen (unless documents by prescriber liquid nitrogen not appropriate)
  - Tretinoin 0.05% cream\*\*
