Non-Formulary **zuranolone (Zurzuvae)** requires a clinical review. Appropriateness of therapy will be based on the following criteria:

Initiation (new start) criteria Non-Formulary **zuranolone (Zurzuvae)** will be covered on the prescription drug benefit for 1 month when the following criteria are met:

- Patient has a diagnosis of post-partum depression (onset no earlier than third trimester of pregnancy and no later than four weeks postpartum)
- Patient is age 18-45 years
- Patient is less than 12 months postpartum
- Patient has Patient Health Questionnaire (PHQ-9) score ≥ 15 within 2 weeks prior to treatment initiation
- Patient has a negative pregnancy test within one week prior to ordering prescription
- Patient does not have a diagnosis of bipolar disorder, schizophrenia, or schizoaffective disorder
