

# Criteria Based Consultation Prescribing Program

## CRITERIA FOR DRUG COVERAGE

### amphetamine salt combo (Mydayis®)

Non-formulary **amphetamine salt combo (Mydayis®)** will be covered on the prescription drug benefit when the following criteria are met:

- Diagnosis of ADHD or ADD **-AND-**

#### 1) For patients 13 to 20 years of age:

- Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of amphetamine salt combo XR (Adderall XR), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.  
**-AND-**
- Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of dextroamphetamine ER (Dexedrine Spansule), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.  
**-AND-**
- Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 days) of lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.  
**-OR-**
- Patient is already stable on the drug.

#### 2) For patients 21 years of age or older:

- Prior adequate trial\*\* of amphetamine salt combo XR (Adderall XR), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.  
**-AND-**
- Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 day) of dextroamphetamine ER (Dexedrine Spansule), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.  
**-AND-**
- Prior adequate trial\*\* (7 day) of lisdexamfetamine (Vyvanse), **unless** allergy to an inactive ingredient.

\*\* Adequate trial of a short acting agent is further defined as wearing off that is not resolved by increasing the dose, AND adding a short-acting agent OR increasing frequency to twice daily OR clinically significant side effects related to the dosage form that cannot be resolved by adjusting the dose or timing.
