

How to Pay Your Premium Bill Online

Kaiser Permanente offers a no cost and easy way to pay your premium bill online with flexible payment options — including the convenience of automatic payments.

Your premium is your monthly health plan payment and you can pay it by phone, mail, or online.

When you pay online, you choose what works best for you —setting up automatic payments or making a one-time payment.

Enrolling in automatic payments is the easiest way to stay on track, giving you peace of mind that your premium is paid on time each month.

You also have the option to receive notifications and enroll in paperless billing based on your preferences in your kp.org account.

Get started

To get started, visit kp.org/payonline.

If you are viewing your bill online or electronically, you can also select the payment link directly from your bill.

You'll sign in with your kp.org account, or you can register for an account if you don't have one.

Once you're logged in, you'll land on your Premium billing summary, where you can make payments and manage your premium account.

Set up automatic payments

From the Premium billing summary page, select Set up automatic payments and follow the guided steps.

You'll choose when payments begin, how often they occur, and how long they continue.

Choose a payment date on or before your due date to avoid late payments.

Once you review and accept the terms and conditions and click Submit, you're all set — giving you one less thing to manage each month.

You can always make changes later from your Premium Billing Summary by selecting Manage automatic payments.

Make a one-time payment

If you prefer to make a one-time payment instead, you can do that from the same Premium billing summary page.

Select Pay, then choose the amount, method, and date.

Like with automatic payments, choose a date on or before your due date, review your details, accept the terms and conditions, and Submit.

Pay as a guest

If you're paying a premium for someone else, you can go to kp.org and select Pay Bills, then choose the member's region. From there, select Make a guest payment under the Premium bill section, and you'll be guided through the remaining steps.

You can find all the information you need, including your billing unit ID, or BUID, on your premium statement.
